



Saint Catherine's Vision is founded in a discipline of prayer, conciliarity and study, with roots reaching to the early 1980's. It is a Pan-Orthodox Christian organization endorsed by the Assembly of Canonical Orthodox Bishops of the United States of America engaging concerns of the contemporary Church.

We strive to build our efforts on a spiritual foundation, working collaboratively. We believe that it takes a disciplined village with humility to bear witness and share God's restorative and transfiguring eleos, loosely translated as Divine Compassion or Mercy, to His people and creation.
